

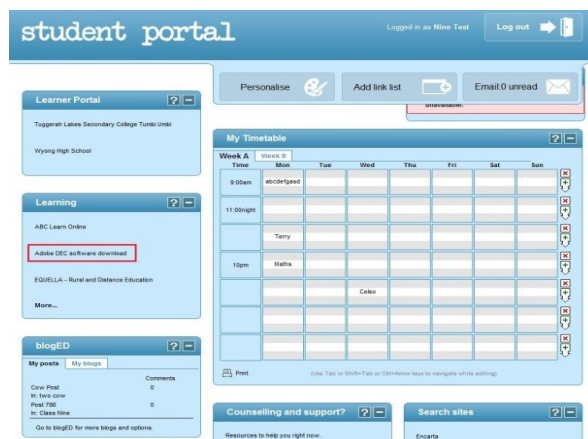
Adobe Creative Cloud

Student download guide

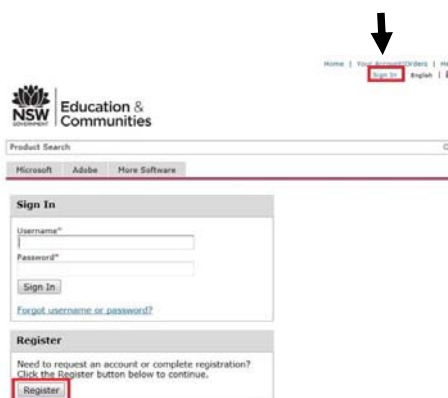
IMPORTANT: This process may not work properly through the DoE proxy settings at school so make sure you download, install and activate the software at home.

Students can download and use the Adobe Creative Cloud for free on one personally owned device. This step-by-step guide outlines the process for downloading the Adobe CC software.

1. Login to the student portal using your DoE Username and password
2. Within the Learning portlet, click on **Adobe DoE Download Software**. You will then be directed to the OnTheHub website



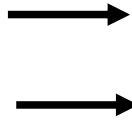
3. Click on the **Sign in** link and enter your School/DoE Username (firstname.lastname@education.nsw.gov.au) and password



Then click on the **Register** button



- 4. Enter your DoE/School email address (firstname.lastname@education.nsw.gov.au) and click **Continue**



- 5. A confirmation email will be sent you your DoE/School email account.

Open your School email and find the confirmation email, then click on the confirmation URL to validate your email address.

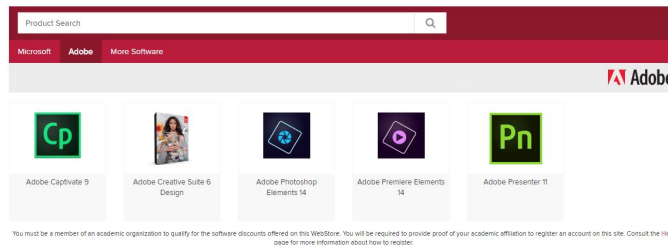
- 6. Your DoE/School Username and email address will automatically be populated in the Account Registration page. Complete the form by filling in the compulsory fields, identified by an asterisk (*) and click **Register**.



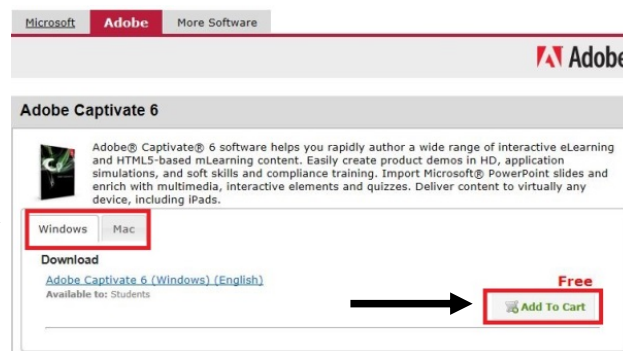
- 7. A login will be created. You can now order software by clicking on **Download Software**



8. Click on the **Adobe** tab and select the software you wish to download from the currently available selection (this changes as new software is released)



9. Select the **Windows** or **Mac** version and then click on **Add to Cart**

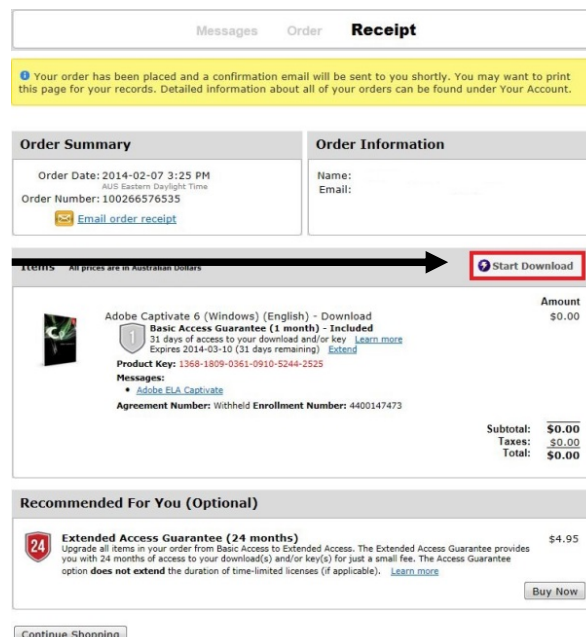


10. Click on **Check Out** or **Continue Shopping**

11. The next page will show the expiry date of the software that is being downloaded. Click **Continue**

12. Check your order details and click on **Proceed With Order**

13. Click **Start Download**

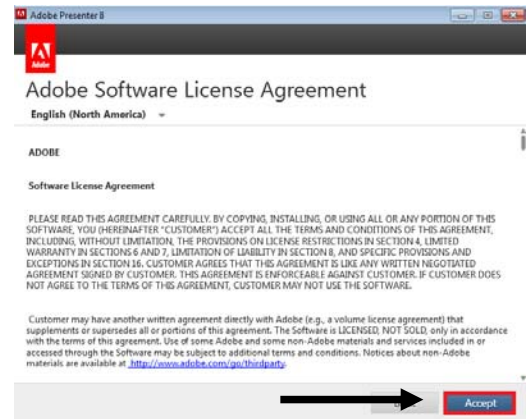
23. When the files are downloaded, select **Launch**. Adobe software file extraction and installation will begin.



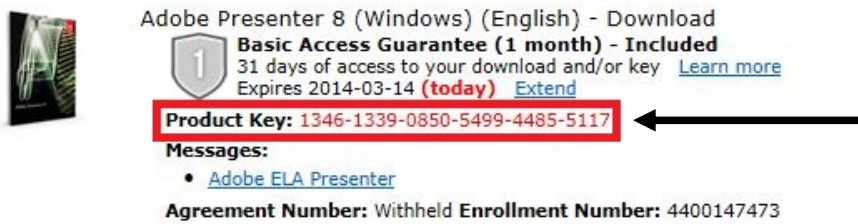
24. Select Install with a serial number



25. Click Accept on the license agreement



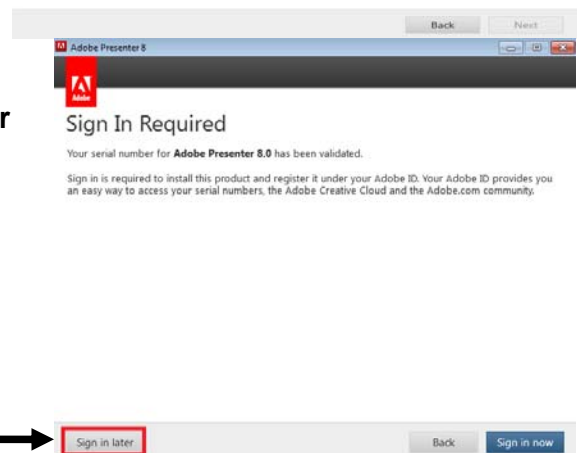
26. The Serial Number is the **Product Key** shown in your order and is required for installation



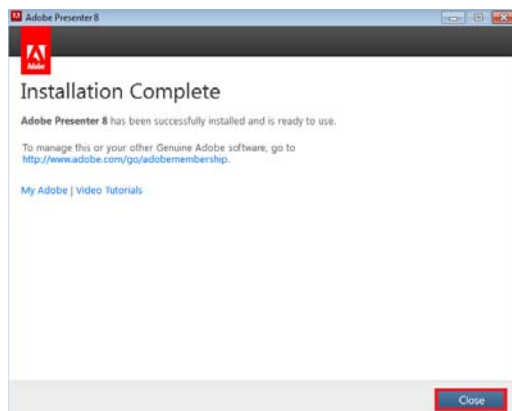
27. Enter the Product Key provided into the serial key section. Click **Next**



28. The serial number will be validated. You are now ready to launch the software. Click on **Sign in Later** and then select **Install**.
