SNOW EXCURSION CODE OF CONDUCT

To ensure that both you and your parent/s or guardian are fully aware of the **code of behaviour** that is to be adhered to whilst you are under the care and supervision of teachers, please read the following list of points.

If, and only if, you agree to abide by these conditions are you to tick the box on the Schoolbytes form. I would ask that one of your parents or a guardian is present when you read this document.

- Smoking or vaping will not be tolerated. This rule applies from the time you depart school until your return at the conclusion of the excursion.
- Any dealings with alcohol and/or drugs are forbidden. The consequence of breaking this rule is being sent home and for drug offences also having the police notified. Your removal from the program and return home will be at your expense.
- You will attend all lessons for ski/board in the designated areas with instructors.
- You are bound to observe the directions always given to you by members of staff and other supervising adults.
- Your behaviour should be such that it brings credit to yourself, your family and your school.
- You understand that you are responsible for all your ski/snowboard hire equipment and that any deliberate damage or loss of equipment is your responsibility, and you should be prepared to pay the cost of lost or damaged equipment to ski hire.
- You will be on time for **all compulsory attendance roll marking procedures** as outlined by your supervising teachers.

You should see yourself as fortunate to be attending such a program, as there are many students who do not get this opportunity.

Responsible behaviour should ensure a great time for both students and staff attending.
